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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner contends that many cases are registered against the petitioner regarding theft of the batteries of mobile towers. Therefore, he was on run.

Learned senior counsel has drawn the attention of the Court towards order dated 18.12.2014 (Annexure-P-5), passed by this Court in CRM No. M-26806 of 2014. He has stated that the petitioner could not appear before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, on 26.11.2014 and non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued. In this case, the challan has not been presented.

In these circumstances, the petitioner is directed to put in appearance before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, immediately. On appearance of the petitioner before the learned ASJ, Amritsar, his non-bailable warrants will stand cancelled.

The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
