This is a petition for the grant of anticipatory bail filed in case bearing FIR No. 312 dated 08.10.2014, under Sections 419/420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Furrukh Nagar, District Gurgaon.

Affidavit of Shareef Singh, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Pataudi(Gurgaon) has been filed in response to order dated 05.02.2015.

Learned counsel states that now the petitioner has returned the entire money paid by Suraj Bhan and Suraj Bhan has relinquished any claim to the property of complainant Rohtas. Learned DAG, on instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. In the event of his arrest he be released on bail to the satisfaction of the investigating officer subject to

the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
