The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.59 dated 27.06.2011, registered under Sections 498-A, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Bholath, Distt. Kapurthala.

The learned counsel contends that the petitioner, who was earlier granted bail, had been appearing regularly before the trial Court. On 04.05.2015, when the case came up for hearing, he could not reach the Court in time due to some unavoidable circumstances. The absence was not deliberate or intentional. The petitioner is not involved in any other FIR.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. A complete copy of the paper book has been handed over to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Without adverting to the merits of the present case, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case, the petitioner appears before the trial Court within one week from today, he shall be admitted to bail by the trial Court, on furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to its satisfaction.
