Present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail on the ground that petitioner not named in FIR. Earlier he was arrested in the case and was released on bail on 03.07.2014. He was absent from the proceeding of the Court and his bail was cancelled. Petitioner could not appear in the Court, there was no motive for him not to be present in the Court and his absence was unintentional otherwise he had been regularly attending the Court.

Having considered these facts, that petitioner was earlier released on bail and had been attending the Court regularly except for single default. Petitioner is hereby ordered to be admitted to bail on furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Judge. However,

trial Judge may proceed to complete the proceeding under Section 446 of Cr.P.C. against the petitioner as well.

Petition disposed of.
