RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for directing the respondents to safeguard the life of the petitioners and not to harass the petitioners at the instance of accused named in complaint dated 13.08.2013 (Annexure P-3).

Upon notice, status report on behalf of the respondents, in the shape of affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural) has been filed, wherein it has been stated that Dalbir Singh-petitioner No.1 made his statement on 14.08.2013 before ASI Gurwinder Singh to the effect that he was standing outside the Gurdwara of village Kamoke on 12.08.2013 along with Bachittar Singh-petitioner No.2, Bhagwan Singh and his daughter-in-law Talwinder Kaur. In the meantime, persons detailed in para No.2 of the reply, came there and attacked them with sharp edged weapons. These persons were nursing a grudge, as the petitioner had contested the election of Sarpanch against them. On the basis of statement made by Dalbir Singh, FIR No.249 dated 21.10.2013, under Sections

326/324/323/148/149 IPC (Annexure R-1/T) was registered at Police Station, Beas, District Amritsar (Rural) and the investigation was in progress.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilbag Singh, has informed the Court that after completion of investigation in the FIR, a cancellation report has been prepared on 21.10.2014, which has been approved by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural). He has further stated that the cancellation report will be filed before the Court in due course.

In view of the said fact, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition at this stage, as the petitioner can avail his remedy before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
