SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Petitioners have applied for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 67, dated 06.05.2015, under Sections 353/332/186/427/341/149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana.

The case of the prosecution is that Janak Raj-ASI was present for investigation of accidental death of child Kajol. People gathered on the spot and stopped the parents of the girl child from making any statement. ACP, Ludhiana alongwith gunman also reached there to obtain the consent of the parents of the child. Later on, parents alongwith dead body of the child were taken in a Bolero vehicle bearing registration No. PB-10-DM-4206. Thereafter, 40-45 persons stopped the vehicle. At that time, Shankar and Fatma were throwing bricks and the vehicle being used by the police officials was damaged and the incident resulted into injuries to two police officials.

Learned counsel for the petitioners took the plea that prosecution story is false. The petitioners, namely, Pushpa Devi, Sanoj Shah and Shiv Shankar, are ready to join the investigation. So, they be released on

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anticipatory bail.

Learned State counsel has opposed the application for anticipatory bail on the ground that allegations against the petitioners are serious in nature and custodial investigation is required. Hence, bail application be dismissed.

Having considered the rival submissions, present case does not call for release of the petitioners on anticipatory bail, as they had taken the course of law in their own hands and two police officials were injured. Even the property belonging to police i.e. vehicle was damaged by the petitioners.

In view of above, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made out.

Petition dismissed.
