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**JASPAL SINGH, J.**

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 121, dated 12.11.2012, under Sections 366 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom.

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that complainant and accused have voluntarily arrived at a compromise. However,

victim/Kamaljit Kaur has also furnished an affidavit mentioning the fact that she has no objection, if the present FIR is quashed. Her statement could not be recorded as she is away to foreign country. Otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

**3.** In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

**4.** Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 121, dated 12.11.2012, under Sections 366 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioners. However, still Kamaljit Kaur shall be at liberty to challenge this order, if she feels so aggrieved.
