AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.87 dated 10.07.2015 registered under Section 306 IPC at P.S. Shambu, District Patiala.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh has stated that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant the

concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
