Allegations against the present petitioner are that the petitioner alongwith co-accused namely Ajit Pal, Ashish and Jai Ram, armed with weapons tried to loot the passersby. On receipt of secret information, a police party headed by SI Sandeep reached the spot. It is stated that when they reached at the spot one of the accused, who was later on identified as Ajit Pal, put the pistol on the temple of SI Sandeep and asked to hand-over whatever is available with him. Other police officials overpowered the man alongwith the pistol. It was found that the present petitioner was also apprehended from the spot. Two other escaped from the spot.

Learned State counsel has placed on file list of 18 cases which has been registered between January 2014 to June 2014 against the present petitioner in District Rohtak, Fatehabad, Jind and

Sonepat, involving the offences of similar nature.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that petitioner is on bail in 9 of these cases and that he is a poor labourer from Uttar Pradesh and has been involved in false cases. Keeping in view the nature of the offence and the previous history mentioned above, the present petition for grant of regular bail, stands dismissed.

However, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.
