ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 17 dated 04.02.2015, registered under Sections 392 IPC and Section 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner urges that four cases were registered against the petitioner in a span of one and a half month and the name of the petitioner was disclosed by co-accused and the petitioner is on bail in FIR No. 15, 16 & 18. It was urged that in all the cases almost similar allegations have been levelled and the cases have been planted.

State counsel submits that there are more cases against the petitioner under Section 399, 402 IPC and the petitioner had made a confessional statement regarding the occurrence.

As per the prosecution version, the complainant and Sukha Singh were proceeding at a motorcycle at about 8:00 PM. Four men came in muffled faces and stopped them and a pistol was placed on the ear and they snatched the motorcycle and the mobile.

The petitioner was arrested in this case on 13.02.2015 and challan has been presented. Without commenting upon the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial would take time, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court subject to the condition that the petitioner would not indulge in similar kind of cases during the trial.
