ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.80 dated 03.07.2015, registered under Sections 326, 323, 324, 354, 452, 427, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the injury under Section 326 IPC is not attributed to the petitioners and the complaint has been made by the husband of petitioner no.1.

It appears that there is a matrimonial dispute and earlier also an incident had taken place and an FIR had been registered. The injury under Section 326 IPC is not attributed to

the petitioners. The trial would take time. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, however, subject to the condition that there would be no further incident between the parties.
