This revision petition has been filed by the petitioners against their concurrent conviction by the Courts below under Sections 323, 325, 326, 34 of the IPC.

On 19.8.2015, the following contention was noticed :-

“ At the very outset learned counsel states that the petitioner has been filed against the concurrent conviction of the petitioners under Sections 323/325/326/34 IPC and the petitioners were sentenced to three years imprisonment. They have undergone five months out of their total sentence and now the parties have

arrived at a compromise.”

Thereafter, the report of the CJM Sirsa has been received whereby it has been corroborated that the parties have indeed compromised the matter.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that the parties were collateral and the dispute arose over the turn of water and, therefore, it would be appropriate to honour the compromise and not to ignore it.

Learned DAG Haryana has argued that in any case, this Court cannot and should not either quash the proceedings or acquit the petitioners but he has fairly accepted that the compromise should not be completely ignored if it had not taken place at all.

I find merit in the argument of counsel for the respondent and, therefore, dismiss the revision petition while maintaining the conviction. However, sentenced is reduced to the period which the petitioner have already undergone.
