The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.37 dated 13.06.2015, under Section 420 of IPC, registered with Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda.

As per the allegations, the petitioner is alleged to have taken a sum of Rs.21,50,000/- to secure the employment for the complainant as Inspector in the Markfed.

It is contended that the petitioner is in custody since 18.06.2015 and on completion of the investigation, the challan has been presented.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from H.C. Pritam Singh, does not refute with the contention that the investigation is over.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the fact that the investigation is over and the trial would take

considerable period of time, no purpose would be served to keep the petitioner/accused-Bagga Singh in custody any longer, the prayer for regular bail is allowed and accordingly, he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.
