Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Resham Singh, has stated at the bar that petitioner has joined the investigation and weapon of offence has been recovered.

Learned State counsel has further submitted that proceeding declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender were initiated, but she is unable to tell the Court whether the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender or not. However, State counsel has admitted that there is no order in the police file declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender/person.

So, in these circumstances, the order dated 26.08.2014, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
