The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.150, dated 23.10.2013, registered under Sections 302, 323, 148, 149 of the IPC, at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur.

Allegation in the FIR against the petitioner is of lalkara. Counsel for the petitioner has argued that he has now been in custody for the last six months. The main accused who had caused the injuries are in custody.

Learned counsel for the complainant, as well as learned Addl.

AG Punjab have not been able to dispute these factual assertions.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
