The complainants are seeking a direction to the police authorities for restraining the accused persons and their supporters from causing hindrance in adducing their evidence in FIR No.92 dated 16.12.2011, under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran.

Some of the accused are stated to be declared proclaimed offenders evading the trial in the said FIR.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioners very fairly submits that the present petition has become infructuous in the light of the trial having approached its fag end.

Hence, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
