The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No.350 dated 24.08.2014 registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, Police Station Sector-39, U.T. Chandigarh and all the consequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of written compromise arrived at between the parties.

Complainant is present today and has got recorded his statement that matter is compromised and he has received draft of Rs.6,55,000/- and Rs.25,000/- in cash and he has no objection if the FIR is quashed.

Learned counsel for the State submits that petitioner is the only accused and respondent no.2 is the only aggrieved person in this FIR.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the FIR pending.

In view of the statements and report of the trial Court and the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, approved by Hon'ble Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, the instant petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings conducted on the basis thereof are quashed.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements made in the Court below.
