Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.239 dated 04.07.2015, under Section 420, IPC registered with Police Station Sector 26, U.T., Chandigarh.

As per the complainant-Smt. Bimla Devi, the petitioner-Monika has induced the complainant to pay a sum of Rs.2 Lacs through cheque for sending her to Singapore. Instead of, she was sent to Saudi Arabia.

Learned APP for U.T., Chandigarh, on instructions from SI Jagtar Singh, submits that although the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, she is not cooperating in getting effected the recovery of the amount.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and offered her signatures for comparison, this Court finds that she deserves the concession of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, interim order dated 24.08.2015 is made absolute.
