Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 63 dated 27.05.2013, under Sections 323, 452, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar City, on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Mohinder Kaur alleging that the petitioners along with 15 young boys trespassed in the house of complainant armed with iron rods and *dattar* and inflicted injuries to her and her sons with iron rods, *dattar* etc. Petitioner No.1 gave a rod blow, which hit

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on her left eye; petitioners No.2 and 3 gave injuries and petitioner No.4 gave rod blow which hit on her left wrist. Petitioner No.5 gave *dattar* blow from reverse side, which hit on her left wrist.

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been sent to this Court intimating that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the condition that all the petitioner will deposit a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with the Punjab Police Welfare Fund, Sector 9, Chandigarh, within a period of one month.
