This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for the rectification of typographical error in the head note and prayer clause of the petition and for placing on record the amended petition.

For the reasons recorded, application is allowed.

Amended application is taken on record.

C.R.M-M No.26970-2015

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.337 dated 30.12.2014 registered under Sections 22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic

Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Phillaur, Jalandhar

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that apart from the merits of the case the petitioner has now been in custody since 31.12.2014.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from Head Constable Iqbal Singh has accepted this factual assertions and has further stated that there are total 11 witnesses and the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 24.12.2015 and till such time bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Deputy Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 24.12.2015 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
