Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 324 dated November 3, 2011, under Sections 420, 120-B, 494, 495 IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur District SAS Nagar, at the instance of Ajmer Singh, alleging that his daughter was married to petitioner No.3 and was turned out of the matrimonial home as petitioner No.3 was already married.

Sumanjit Kaur and Kamaljit Kaur named in the FIR are not made party in the compromise.

Statement of the complainant and Kulwinder Kaur has been recorded. It appears that the mater having been compromised, the complainant and the effected girls do not want to proceed against the petitioners.

In view of the judgment of Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others**, 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052, the petition is allowed. FIR No. 324 dated November 3, 2011, under Sections 420, 120-B, 494, 4985 IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur District SAS Nagar, and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise, subject to petitioners paying an additional sum of Rs.20000/- to respondent No.3 for unnecessary harassment within a period of one month in the shape of bank draft in her name. In case of non-compliance of the above said condition, it will be open to the complainant to approach this Court for seeking revival of this petition.
