FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 04.09.2014 of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr.Divn.)-cum-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Malerkotla has been received whereby after recording statements of LR's of complainant Paramjit Kaur (since deceased) namely Baljit Kaur, Mandip Kaur, Ramandeep Kaur (minor) and Gursewak Singh (minor) and the accused persons namely Mohd. Akbar @ Soni and Mohammad Amjad @ Naag, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has

been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

It has been brought to the notice of this Court that instant FIR against the similarly placed co-accused has already been quashed vide orders dated 24.03.2014 of this Court.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, the fact that parties belong to the same very area and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences and in bringing about peace and harmony and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.141 dated 21.08.2008 registered at Police Station City Malerkotla, District Sangrur under Sections 323/427/452/506/379/148/149 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR are quashed qua the present petitioners.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
