This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No. 149 dated 01.06.2013 under Section 380 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station 'A' Division, District Amritsar, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR.

Respondent No.2 i.e. complainant is present who has been identified by ASI Jasbir Singh of Police Station 'A' Division, Amritsar who also happens to be investigating officer.

Respondent No.2 had submitted that he does not want to proceed with the case in any manner against petitioner No.1 and that his daughter-Komal is living with her husband i.e. petitioner No.1 in the matrimonial home.

The investigating officer also stated that ornaments stand recovered.

Complainant does not want to pursue the case under the FIR against the petitioner No.2 and he has no objection if the FIR is quashed and further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR also are quashed.

So, in view of the above circumstances, the above said FIR stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR also stand quashed.
