This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the trial Court to decide complaint No.2821 of 2013 titled as 'M/s Shree Sai International Vs. Gurmail Singh & another' which is pending since 2013, after summoning of the accused.

Notice of motion was issued on 14.08.2015 and the trial Court was directed to file status report in the case.

In response thereto, a report has been sent by trial Court wherein it has been mentioned that complaint titled as 'M/s

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Shree Sai International Vs. Gurmail Singh & Others' was instituted on 28.01.2013 and the accused was summoned for 01.04.2014. He appeared before the Court on 08.10.2013 and notice of accusation was served upon him on 06.12.2013. Thereafter, on joint request of the parties the complaint was adjourned to 29.03.2014 as there was a possibility of compromise, but compromise was not effected between the parties and thereafter the case was adjourned for leading the evidence. On 08.07.2014, one witness was present, but he could not be examined as he did not bring the summoned record. On subsequent dates, two witnesses were examined and thereafter case was adjourned on request of complainant to lead the evidence. It has also been mentioned therein that trial is not lingering on without any justified reason.

In view of the status report filed by the trial Court, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to make all efforts to expedite the trial.
