This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.38 dated 14.06.2015 under Sections 323, 324, 342, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.
