By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.43, dated 05.06.2015, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506 and 34 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Gurdaspur.

The learned counsel for the petitioners states in pursuance of the order dated 14.08.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 14.08.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
