The application stands allowed. Additional affidavit of the petitioner-Rajesh Kumar is taken on record.

MAIN CASE

This is a petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner for issuing the direction to the respondent Nos. 2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and not to harass and humiliate the petitioner at the instance of respondent Nos. 6 to 8.

The petitioner is the son of respondent No. 6-Hans Raj and he is living in Dera. The stands taken by the respondent Nos. 6 to 8 is that the petitioner is a drug addict.

Report of the Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh, has been received in which it is mentioned that there is no sign of taking drugs by the petitioner.

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Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 6 to 8 have made a statement that they are living in separate district and will not interfere in the life of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has also made a statement that police officials will not interfere in the life of the petitioner.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage.

So, the present petition stands dismissed as not pressed.

The respondents shall be bound by their respective statements.
