1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the Digest?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

At the very outset, learned counsel states that inadvertently there is mistranslation of Annexure P-1 where instead of Punjab School Education Board it has been mentioned as Board of Secondary Education Rajasthan. She has shown the Court the original certificate and as that the photocopy of the vernacular of Annexure P-1 which reveals that the Board from which the petitioner No.1 had done her matriculation is Punjab School Education Board. In the circumstances, in the document Annexure P-1 the Board of Secondary Education Rajasthan be read as Punjab School Education Board.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the

Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the

life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Secondary Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 10.09.1996 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of School Leaving Certificate (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 31.12.1977. They have also moved a representation before the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
