Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR of the year 2009 in an assault case on the ground that his co-accused have been acquitted by the trial Court after examination of the witnesses. The petitioner was not able to get the similar relief as he had opted to evade appearance before the Court.

The acquittal of the co-accused while the petitioner played hide and seek with the court cannot be made a ground for seeking quashing of the FIR. Besides this, the petition has been filed through power of attorney holder while the petitioner is stated to be abroad.

No ground is made out for quashing of the FIR.

The petition is dismissed without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner to approach this Court for expeditious disposal of trial informing the Court the tentative date of his return to India in order to enable him to face the trial.
