This petition has been filed for quashing the impugned FIR No.50 dated 06.04.2006 registered under Sections 420, 406 IPC at Police Station Ferozepur.

The allegations were that the petitioner sold a car to the complainant-respondent No.2 but later on because of his friendly relations borrowed the car and sold it to somebody else. The allegations reveal that it is not a criminal offence but the civil in nature.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
