Pursuant to the interim order dated 31.08.2015, all the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and get their statements recorded, after having been released on bail to the effect that the matter has been compromised amicably.

This is a petition for quashing of FIR No.7 dated 17.01.2011, under Sections 498-A/406, IPC, registered at Police Station, Mukandpur, District S.B.S. Nagar, at the instance of respondent No.2, who was allegedly maltreated by the petitioners for having brought insufficient dowry.

The matter having been compromised, their statements stand recorded. A report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily.

In view of husband and wife having parted company on receiving lump sum alimony, the matrimonial controversy having been resolved, following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal), 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed, on the basis of compromise.
