This is the second petition filed by the petitioner for the grant of regular bail, the first one having been dismissed as withdrawn on 22.4.2014.

The petitioner is facing trial in a case under Sections 20 and 27-A of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. He is behind the bars since 16.2.2013.

After obtaining instructions from SI Kanwar Pal, learned State counsel has informed the Court that the prosecution has since examined its entire evidence. Even, the accused has been examined under Section 313 Cr.P.C. and now the case is fixed before the trial Court for defence and arguments for today.

Once, the trial has almost come to its fag end, the petitioner cannot be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
