The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 for quashing of the FIR No. 44 dated 23.6.2010, under Sections 452, 336/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, and 25/54/59 of Arms Act 1959, registered at Police Station, Barnala, District Barnala alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 22.9.2012 (Annexure P-2).

In pursuant to the order dated 13.10.2014 passed by this Court, report of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala, recieved. She has reported that statements of the petitioners as well

as Paramjit Kaur (widow) and Ranjot Singh- son of complainant (since deceased) have been recorded. It has been reported to this Court that a compromise is effected between the parties and the same is voluntary and genuine.

The allegations in the case are that accused entered the house of the complainant and one of the accused fired two shots with .12 bore double barrel gun in the air. No injury was caused. Parties are stated to be neighbours. As the parties have effected compromise and the trial is still at initial stage as no witness is stated to have been examined so far.

Since, the LRs of the complainant has amicably settled the dispute with the accused, therefore, the FIR in question alongwith consequential proceedings stands quashed.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
