AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.131 dated 24.06.2015 registered under Sections 307, 341, 324, 323, 354, 509, 506, 427, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Kotwali, District Faridkot.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail and that a

direction be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Allowed as prayed for.

Let the petitioner surrender before the trial Court on 01.09.2015 and move an application for regular bail which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any case within 2 days on merits. It is made clear that in case the petitioner does not surrender before the Court in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
