Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a cross-case. The original case was registered at the instance of petitioner under Sections 302, 148, 149 IPC read with Section 25/27 of the Arms Act.

A cross-version was got recorded by complainant Darbara Singh son of Surender Singh alleging that the petitioner along with other co-accused formed unlawful assembly and attacked him and his family members armed with *rifle* and *datar*. Fatal injuries were received by sister of the complainant who died on account of firearm injuries. So far as petitioner is concerned, he has not been attributed any injury on the person of the complainant or other persons. Though he was armed with *datar* but only *lalkara* has been attributed.

Since the main case was registered at the instance of the petitioner and in the cross-version he has not been attributed any injury and he being in custody w.e.f. 28.05.2015, can be granted concession of bail.

This petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Taran Taran.
