The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in Criminal Complaint No. 64/1/10 dated 10.5.2010.

The petitioner had been summoned in February 2012. Despite service he failed to appear and was declared proclaimed offender in 2013.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the trial against the remaining had ended in acquittal. He states that cross case was registered against the complainant side which ended in their conviction.

The petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender. Question of grant of anticipatory bail does not arise. The petitioner will have to surrender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that some time may be fixed and the petitioner would surrender.

The petitioner will surrender before the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate on 07.09.2015 and will avail the remedies available under law.

The petition is disposed of.
