The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.155, dated 18.6.2015, registered under Sections 312, 315, 316, 109, 120-B of the IPC and Section 15(2) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody for three months and that challan has been presented.

Learned Addl. A.G Punjab, on instructions from HC Nachhattar Singh, has accepted these factual assertions but has argued that the petitioner was guilty of carrying female fetus.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the

case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
