Petitioners No. 1 and 2, who are stated to be major and are widower/widow, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 15.5.2014. The photocopies of Voter Identity Cards, showing the date of birth of both the petitioners have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2. The marriage certificate has been placed on record as Annexure-P-3.

It is claimed that the petitioner No. 2 had moved an application dated 12.12.2014 (Annexure-P-4) before the SHO, Police Station Sadar Hansi, District Hisar, for protecting his life and liberty and that of his wife as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents.

In these circumstances, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, District Hisar, to consider the application dated 12.12.2014 (Annexure-P-4) of the petitioners, moved to the SHO, Police Station Sadar Hansi, District Hisar, and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be taken to be the proof of valid marriage.

Disposed of accordingly.
