Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in FIR No.18 which was registered against the petitioner on 29.12.2014 while the petitioner was already in custody in another case FIR No.12 registered at same police station i.e. Police Station State Special Operation Cell, District Amritsar.

It is an admitted fact that the recovery of 2 kgs and 600 grams of heroin has been effected from Gurminder Singh @ Lali. Petitioner has been charged for offence under Section 29 of the NDPS Act whereas the recovery has been effected from the co-accused.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in FIR No.18 dated 29.12.2014 registered at Police Station State Special Operation Cell, Amritsar on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
