Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Manjinder Singh states that in this case all the dowry articles have been recovered except 5 tola of gold. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the entire recovery has been effected and petitioner denies the possession of the said gold.

The present case has been got registered by mother of the wife of the petitioner against the present petitioner for misappropriation of dowry articles and harassment on account of demand of dowry from her daughter.

Since the petitioner has been thoroughly interrogated, the interim bail granted by this Court on 27.01.2015 to the petitioner is made absolute.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
