Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 688 dated 04.11.2014 (**Annexure P-3**) for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A, 406 and 323 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Yamuna Nagar.

As per allegations, the complainant-Manisha was married to the accused-Rohit Khanna on 24.11.2012, soon after the marriage, there were consistent harassment and demands for dowry. Innova Car is also alleged to have been given by the father of the complainant. There are serious allegations of giving serious beatings as well to the complainant-wife.

The details of the harassment etc. are detailed in the order dated 04.08.2015, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri (**Annexure P-4**).

This Court had issued the notice on the ground to explore the possibility by way of compromise.

The parties are present in Court and after interaction with them, an amicable settlement has not appeared to be possible. Even the mediation proceedings initiated before the Mediation Centre of this Court have been failed.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the allegations, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

The present petition is accordingly dismissed.
