This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioners under Section 379 IPC and Section 21 of the Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, vide FIR No.133 dated 6.6.2015.
