The petitioner/accused has been exonerated in the investigation conducted in FIR No.161 dated 20.10.2014 registered against him for the offences under Sections 323, 324 and 326 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Mehtapur, District Jalandhar and yet no cancellation to date has been filed.

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit dated 15.09.2015 of Sh. Mandeep Singh, DSP, Sub Division Shahkot, District Jalandhar.
