This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for placing on record the complete FIR No.76 dated 04.08.2013 as Annexure P-3 and exemption from filing the certified copy of the same.

Application is allowed. Documents taken on record.

C.R.M-M No.27371-2015

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.76 dated 04.08.2013 registered under Sections 307/323/306/34 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Bahav Wala, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 29.04.2015. He further states that the injured was discharged from the hospital the same day and diagnosed to have sustained blunt injuries and the allegations that shot was fired was only made to make the offence more serious.

Learned Additional Advocate General has accepted the aforementioned facts though she states that empty shell was recovered.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of bail to the present petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
