JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 54, dated 30.05.2014, under Sections 406 and 498-A and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Ludhiana on the basis of compromise.

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise has been effected voluntarily without any pressure and coercion. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that

continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 54, dated 30.05.2014, under Sections 406 and 498-A and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Ludhiana and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioners.
