Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.285 Dated 17.12.2014 under Section 409 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Patra.

The petitioner is alleged to have misappropriated bags of DAP & Urea belonging to a complainant-Cooperative Society. Petitioner is stated to have deposited a sum of Rs.3 lacs towards the shortfall of the aforesaid bags.

Pursuant to the interim directions dated 27.01.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kehar Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court, petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 27th January, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
