The only grievance of the petitioners in this case is that their custody warrants have not been sent to respondent No.2 i.e. Jail Superintendent, Sri Muktsar Sahib, despite cancellation of their bail vide order dated 05.09.2011.

Perusal of the record shows that vide order dated 23.04.2015, learned District & Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, has also issued directions to the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib to deal with the matter, as per rules.

In view of above, learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib i.e. in whose Court the matter is pending, is directed to dispose of the matter expeditiously as per law and preferably within one month from today, as per directions already issued by the learned District & Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, vide order dated 23.04.2015.

The instant petition is disposed of in above terms.
