Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in complaint No.30 dated 03.10.2012 titled as "Hardial Singh versus Tej Kumar and others", under Sections 436, 427, 451, 395, 353, 186, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that qua the same occurrence, FIR No.28 dated 10.06.2012, under Sections 353, 186, 436, 427, 451, 148, 149 IPC was registered at Police Station Joga, District Mansa. In the said case, accused were granted anticipatory bail. Accused Jaspal Singh alias Pal had approached this Court for anticipatory bail and the same was disposed of vide order dated 12.01.2015 in CrI. Misc. No.M-330 of 2015.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case petitioners surrender before the trial Court within ten days from today, they be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
