FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 17.10.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Deepak Verma as well as of complainant Pooja Sharma it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that there is pure matrimonial dispute between the parties and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to settle their future lives and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.145 dated 17.03.2015 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, Police Station,

Manimajra, District Chandigarh and all other consequential proceedings
arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
