JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') for quashing of case FIR No.53 dated 24.06.2014, registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 326, 341, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, (for short, 'the IPC') at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

The complainant, who is present in person, has specifically stated that he being a labourer, is being forced to enter into a

compromise. Otherwise, there is a threat to his life and liberty as well as to his family members and the compromise is a result of force and coercion applied on the complainant. In this view of the matter, this Court is not inclined to accept the plea of compromise.

In view of the statement made by the complainant in the Court, no case for quashing the FIR is made out.

Dismissed.
